Your child will have the opportunity to participate in optional adventure activities such as horseback riding, high ropes course, and shooting sports. The Center will provide trained staff who will conduct these activities in the safest manner possible. Due to the risks involved, you may choose not to allow your child to participate in these activities. *Under Georgia Law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 12 of title 4 of the official Code of Georgia annotated.*

Please check activities which your child may **NOT** participate in:

- Horseback Riding**
 Shooting Sports (shotguns, rifle, archery)
 High Ropes Course

If you do not check these activities, then you give permission for your child to participate in these activities

There will be a hypnotist performance during the week. The performance is for entertainment purposes only, and participation is voluntary. Please check one of the following options if you do **NOT** want your child to participate:

- My child may NOT VIEW the hypnotist performance**
 My child MAY VIEW the hypnotist performance, but he/she MAY NOT be hypnotized

If you do not check one, then you give permission for your child to view and participate.

This event is a school function. Students and parents are expected to be familiar with all school policies and camp policies. To protect the safety of all students, the Georgia FFA-FCCLA Center has no-tolerance policies that could immediately result in students being sent home. These policies include but are not limited to:

1. Use of violence or possession of weapons
2. Use of alcohol or drugs
3. Entering the cabin of the opposite sex
4. Being outside the cabin after curfew

Parents or guardians of students who violate policies will be notified to pick up their child.

During the week of camp, we will be taking pictures of teams and students that will be used in the Week-in-Review slide show and for camp promotional material. There may also be surveys conducted pertaining to FFA, FCCLA, and/or the camping program. Please contact the main office if you have a need for exclusion.

The Center has a full time nurse on staff. The nurse will treat for basic injuries and illnesses. Campers will be sent to Newton Medical Center if necessary. The camper fee includes a small insurance policy that will cover illness and injury that occur while at the Georgia FFA-FCCLA Center. This will be primary insurance for the student; medical fees above the maximum limit or fees denied by our insurance will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian.

- I understand that I am attending a Leadership Camp and will conduct myself in a manner that positively represents me, my school, my chapter, and my organization.
- I understand that Summer Leadership Camp is a school event, so school policies apply. If there is a discrepancy between school policies and camp policies, the strictest rule will apply.
- I will participate in the camp program, display a positive attitude, and conduct myself appropriately at all times.
- I will respect all campers, advisors, and staff. I will follow instructions from all adults and camp staff.
- I will not use a cell phone during camp programs and activities.
- I will follow the dress code.
- I will not enter a cabin of the opposite sex or be on the wrong side of the camp.
- I will not enter any other cabins or buildings that they I am not assigned to.
- I will remain in my assigned cabin after curfew.
- I will not bring highly valuable items to camp. If I do bring valuables, I accept full responsibility for those items.
- I will not use language or behavior that is obscene, violent, or racially or sexually inappropriate.
- I will not use tobacco products, alcohol and/or drugs.
- I will not use firearms, weapons, pocket knives and/or firecrackers.
- I will not bring skateboards, scooters, or roller blades.
- I will respect camp property by keeping the facilities clean, not creating graffiti, and not using items such as water balloons, shaving cream, and toilet paper for destructive purposes. I accept responsibility for damages I cause.

I understand that failure to meet with these standards will result in these steps:

1. I will call my parents/guardians and report my conduct not in compliance with these guidelines.
2. At the Director's discretion, this may result in my parents/guardians arranging transportation home.
3. My school's administration may take further disciplinary action.
4. My chapter will be billed for damages that I cause.

I also understand that if I fail to follow no-tolerance policies, including but not limited to use of violence or possession of weapons, use of alcohol or drugs, entering the cabin of the opposite sex, being outside the cabin after curfew, or harassment of another camper or staff, then the following steps may be taken:

1. I will be removed from the facilities.
2. Law enforcement will be contacted.
3. A letter will be sent to my school administrator.
4. I will be suspended from all activities at FFA-FCCLA Centers for up to 18 months.

Camp Policies

FFA-FCCLA Summer Leadership Camp

To be distributed to all campers prior to camp

1. Summer Leadership Camp is a school event, so school policies apply. If there is a discrepancy between school policies and camp policies, the strictest rule will apply.
2. Campers must participate in the camp program, display a positive attitude in all events, and conduct themselves appropriately at all times.
3. Students must show respect to all campers, advisors, and staff. Students will follow instructions from **any** advisors, adult supervisors, and camp staff.
4. Campers may not use cell phones during camp programs and activities.
5. Campers must follow the dress code.
6. Campers may not enter cabins of the opposite sex, nor may they be on the wrong side of the camp. This rule applies for the entire week, including check-in and check-out.
7. Campers may not enter any other cabins or buildings that they are not assigned to.
8. Campers must remain in their assigned cabin after curfew.
9. The Center strongly recommends that students do not bring valuable items to camp. If a camper chooses to bring valuable items such as ipods and cell phones, the Georgia FFA-FCCLA Center is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen items.
10. Language or behavior that is obscene, violent, or racially or sexually inappropriate is prohibited.
11. Use of tobacco products, alcohol and/or drugs is prohibited.
12. Firearms, weapons, pocket knives and/or firecrackers are prohibited.
13. Skateboards, scooters, and roller blades are prohibited.
14. Graffiti or destructive use of items such as water balloons, shaving cream, and toilet paper is prohibited.

Discipline and Dismissal Policy

Failure to follow camp policies will result in these steps:

1. Student will call parent/guardian and report conduct not in compliance with these guidelines.
2. At the Director's discretion, this may result in parent/guardian arranging transportation home.
3. At the student's local school administration's discretion, disciplinary action may be taken by the student's school.
4. Chapter will be billed for damages caused by graffiti or other destructive acts.

In addition, failure to follow no-tolerance policies, including but not limited to use of violence or possession of weapons, use of alcohol or drugs, entering the cabin of the opposite sex, being outside the cabin after curfew, or harassment of another camper or staff, may result in the following steps:

1. Student removed from the facilities
2. Law enforcement contacted
3. A letter sent to school administrator (who may pursue additional disciplinary action)
4. Student suspended from all activities at FFA-FCCLA Centers for up to 18 months

Dress Code

FFA-FCCLA Summer Leadership Camp

To be distributed to all campers prior to camp

During your stay at FFA-FCCLA Summer Leadership Camp, we want you to have the best experience possible. The administrative committee has developed a dress code to assure that no one will feel offended or uncomfortable during his or her stay.

If you choose to dress inappropriately, you will be asked to change. By planning ahead and packing appropriately, you will save yourself the inconvenience of having to change and you will be contributing to a pleasant camp atmosphere.

Dress Code:

Please be advised that this dress code will be enforced for all individuals attending the camp, including staff, advisors, and chaperones. Appropriate shoes, shirts, and shorts or pants are to be worn at all times including meals, morning and night assemblies, recreation functions, when leaving the pool, etc.

1. All clothing must be neat, clean, and acceptable in repair and appearance and must be worn within the bounds of decency and good taste as appropriate for all Camp events.
2. When standing relaxed with arms straight by the camper's side, the length of shorts, dresses, skirts, or overalls must be as long as the camper's longest finger. The length of cut-off shorts must also meet the above requirement where the shorts begin to unravel.
3. Articles of clothing which display profanity, products, or slogans which promote tobacco, alcohol, drugs, sex or are in any other way distracting or inappropriate, are prohibited.
4. Excessively baggy or tight clothing, and clothing which advertises any gang symbols or affiliation is prohibited.
5. Items of clothing which expose bare midriffs, bare chests, undergarments, or that are transparent (see-through) are prohibited. Tank tops are permitted as long as they cover all parts and have straps that cover undergarments. Please be advised that tube tops, shirts that expose a bare back, and halter tops are prohibited.
6. For safety reasons, campers are not permitted to wear flip flops during the morning and afternoon except at the pool. After supper, sandals and flip flops are allowed for evening activities.
7. Swimming (For all water recreation):
 - Swimsuits for men: Swim trunks only (No shorts, cut-off pants, or Speedos).
 - Swimsuits for women: One-piece suits recommended, however, two-piece suits are allowed as long as they are modestly cut. No string, thong or crochet suits will be allowed.

Common sense in dress will make a better camp experience for everyone. Please note that camp staff, advisor and chaperone discretion applies to all of the above.
